Primary Purpose & Responsibilities

As a **Direct Support Professional (DSP)** working in Eden's Adult Residential, Day or Employment Programs, you will be working with adults with autism, which requires being reliable and trustworthy, having patience, and demonstrating care and compassion. The primary purpose of these positions is to provide assistance to adult participants, which includes mastering life skills, life-enhancing goals, and employment skills, as well as help with daily life skills such as cooking, cleaning, dressing, bathing, participating in recreational activities and social events, and more. DSPs will also provide one-on-one coaching to individuals with autism, observe and document their progress, administer medication, transport individuals as needed to and from medical facilities, dental appointments, etc., and provide and maintain a safe environment.
