Eden Autism Among First in Nation to Earn NCASES Accreditation for Adult Services

The Eden School Achieves it's 5th Accreditation

Eden Autism is proud to announce that the organization has been accredited by the National Commission for the Accreditation of Special Education Services (NCASES). While this is the fifth time the Eden School has earned accreditation, this marks the first time for the Adult Services program.

Eden remains part of the elite group of fewer than 30 special education programs across the country that have earned NCASES accreditation and an even smaller group of providers whose adult services are now accredited.

"Eden Autism ranks as one of the highest performing organizations meeting the needs of those living on the autism spectrum," said Shawn Kurrelmeier-Lee, lead site reviewer for NCASES. "Eden Autism's leadership in the field paves the way for others to replicate their innovative and exemplary programs."

NCASES is the country's leading accreditation program for private special education services and was established in 1992 by the National Association of Private Special Education Centers (NAPSEC). The organization was established in response to a need for private special education providers to have an accreditation process that uniquely addresses the programs and the populations they serve.

"During the site review, the team noted that Eden is such a special program, doing amazing things," said Dr. Rachel Tait, Eden Autism Chief Program Officer. "From teaching, speech and language services, nursing, job placements, behavior support, residential services, and everything in between, Eden really showcases what it means to have a top-quality program. I am always proud to be a part of Eden and the great things that we do to support individuals with autism, but I am especially proud when

other professionals are able to identify those great things in just a three-day visit and truly capture who we are and what we do."

"My colleagues do exceptional work supporting individuals throughout their lifespan, and it is an honor to have other professionals recognize their efforts," said Michael Decker, Eden Autism President & CEO.

Based on the criteria set forth by the NCASES commission, Eden was lauded for our efforts and teaching methods. The site team had nothing but positive things to say about everyone they spoke to and the programs they observed; in the school, Adult Day, and Residential programs. They spoke extensively to the dedication and commitment of the Eden staff to the students and adults we work with and how the "family" feeling at Eden was a notable presence. This new accreditation period will last for four years.

The Eden School

Going Beyond the Classroom

During the 2022-2023 school year, the Eden School helped 77 students learn daily living skills in the classroom and in the community. There are countless skills that students work on in the classroom—from washing their face and setting the table to reading and communication skills. While it's important to master these tasks in the classroom, the ultimate goal is to bring these skills into the home and community to further their independence.

Through the school's Salad Express program, students put all of their kitchen skills together at once as the final step toward employment.

"We're generalizing a lot of the skills they already know," said Tara Upperco, Teaching Assistant. "It is awesome if they can peel and dice an apple for themselves to eat, but at work, they have to be able to peel and dice a lot more apples in a certain amount of time. We are taking a task they already know and generalizing it so they can use it for employment. They will be ready when they graduate. They're only in school for so many years. They are going to spend more time in the adult center than they are here, so we are getting them ready to be successful."

It is through Salad Express and other initiatives in the Eden School's Transition to Employment program that students learn skills for jobs in restaurants, offices, hospitality settings, retail businesses, and numerous other paid employment opportunities.



Hugh Preece, Salt Creek Grille President & Operating Partner, said hiring Eden students is a win-win. "People with disabilities amaze you, and you learn from them on a daily basis as they learn from you," he said.

The students take care of tasks in the front and back of Salt Creek Grille. They prepare the bar and drink areas, fold napkins, chop vegetables, and do other prep work to ensure things run smoothly for their colleagues and customers. These tasks may seem small, but they have a big impact on the overall operations of the restaurant.

As Eden's students complete the prep work, other employees have more time to expand their own skills. They can learn to cook on the line, enabling them to grow within the company. "It takes a workload off another person to allow them to flourish and learn other skill sets," said Preece.

Tyrone Burston, Lead Teacher of the Transition to Employment Program, said that creating a relationship with the business is a huge part of the program.

"We integrate what Salt Creek Grille does into our school kitchen as much as possible," said Burston. This not only prepares students to work at Salt Creek Grille, but it enables them to secure jobs at restaurants all over New Jersey.

"We really want our kids to be prepared ultimately for jobs when they graduate, and the best place to get that experience is here, in a real kitchen," said Burston. Many students who graduate from the Eden School enter Eden's Adult Services program, where they continue to use the skills they learned to work at businesses across New Jersey.

Having individuals with disabilities in the workforce benefits the entire staff. "Many of the workers are immigrants, and in their countries, you don't see people with challenges. They're kind of invisible in the community," said Preece. "So, this not only helps them have compassion for others, but it really opens up their mind to a different way of thinking."

And that is an important part of what Eden is all about.

"Our mission is to have students integrate into the community and the workplace," said Burston. "It allows our kids and his staff to be part of an inclusive, understanding community."

Celebrating the Class of 2023

Eight exceptional students were celebrated during the Class of 2023 Eden School Commencement. Teachers, parents, and staff came together in June to honor graduating seniors Austin, Brielle, Bryce, Jimmy, Marquis, Riley, Vasu, and Vijay.

"To get to the place where each of our eight graduates are today, they've had to go through their own struggles and overcome the obstacles in their way," said Chief Program Officer Dr. Rachel Tait. "Going through this journey and coming out on the other side has helped take our students from the little boys and little girl they were when they first started with us and help them become the young adults that we witness before us today."

Residential

This summer, Winsten House was renovated to improve accessibility. The entire house was addressed, including the bedrooms, bathrooms, kitchen, and dining areas. Now wheelchair accessible, the new indoor spaces and exterior ramps make the home functional for participants who use a wheelchair or would simply benefit from the assistance of grab bars.

"Ensuring the individuals we support are comfortable, happy, and safe has always been a priority," said Eden Autism President & CEO Michael Decker. "As the number of men and women approaching their senior years grows, this priority is particularly important."

Robbinsville Township generously contributed \$100,000 towards the renovation initiative. Gia Gore, the Director of Real Estate, conveyed her heartfelt appreciation, stating, "Robbinsville has consistently been a staunch supporter of our mission. With over 23 years of experience in developing housing for individuals with special needs, I can confidently affirm that

among all the municipalities I've engaged with throughout New Jersey, Robbinsville stands out as the most supportive and benevolent."

Gia's enthusiasm was evident as she witnessed the realization of the house's transformation. "This is a residence I would personally choose to live in, a place that I would be proud to have my family members reside in as well," she said. "That has always been my ultimate goal—creating a space that caters not only to the residents' practical requirements but also fosters an aesthetically pleasing environment to gracefully age in place."

Several other Eden residences also underwent renovations this year. At Bonnell House, the garage was converted to two ADA bathrooms and the kitchen, family room, and staff office were renovated. A full ADA bathroom was added to Armstrong House, Farrell House received a new roof and flooring throughout the home, and new bedroom flooring was added to Vahlsing House, among several other improvements.

Day & Employment

95% of the participants in our day program are employed or volunteer in the community! While medical needs prevent some individuals from working, all participants work on vocational skills when they are at the day centers. Whether they are helping prepare lunches, cleaning up after meals, doing arts and crafts projects, or grooving during a dance party, there's always something for the men and women to enjoy at our day centers.


